New homes coming to 58 & 66 Emmett Street, Shirley, Christchurch

The Government is delivering more public housing to meet an increasing need in our communities. As part of this work, Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities is redeveloping 58 & 66 Emmett Street, Shirley.

Two new homes will be built; 1 four-bedroom home and 1 five-bedroom home. These will be single-storey homes and will have off street parking.

The site preparation is due to commence in the second quarter. Construction will follow and is expected to be completed around November 2022.

These homes will provide people with a warm, dry, safe place to live.

We will keep you informed as plans progress.

All work will be carried out by contractors with considerable experience and a proven track record. They will ensure all health and safety guidelines are followed at the site and will carry out work in accordance with council guidelines.

Thank you for your patience during the build. At times there will be trucks, diggers and other machinery on site, and this will create some noise and dust. The contractors will be doing all they can to limit this, and will clean up the area afterwards. In the early stages there may also be some vibration.
