The building of much needed new homes will start in your neighbourhood soon. The development will help meet the urgent need for social housing in Gisborne.

New, modern, healthy homes will be built by Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities at 7 Kowhai Street, Gisborne. The development will result in warm, dry homes for three whānau most in need.

What is being proposed?

- **Option 1** 1 x three-bedroom two storey home, 2 x three-bedroom single storey (FUD) homes
- **Option 2** 1 x two-bedroom single storey home, 2 x three-bedroom single storey homes

This development will get more whanau out of unsuitable accommodation and into a healthy place to call home. The new, low maintenance homes will be fully insulated, with carpets, curtains and double glazing.

Keeping disruption to a minimum

Site, noise and traffic management plans will be in place for this development. These provide rules and guidelines about what happens during construction.

The plans will cover items like the hours during which work can be carried out, where contractors can park their vehicles and the control of dust and noise.

When construction begins, we expect building activity to take place between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 5pm on Saturdays, but not on Sundays and public holidays.
