Housing opportunities near where you live

As most of you are aware, a tornado occurred in Levin in May of this year and caused damage to many homes, including some owned by Kāinga Ora Homes and Communities. We know that this event has caused immense stress for residents and been a difficult time for the community, please know our thoughts are with you.

We are also aware there is an urgent need for warmer, dry homes in Levin, so Kāinga Ora Homes and Communities have been looking at the possibility of redeveloping homes on Hinemoa Street and Awatea Street. Due to several homes in this area sustaining damage in the tornado and some neighbouring properties requiring significant upgrades due to age, this work has been brought forward.

The sites we are currently looking at for redevelopment are:

- 54 Hinemoa Street
- 19 and 21 Awatea Street

What's happening?

We're in the early stages of exploring how these sites could be redeveloped for new, fit for purpose homes.

You may notice some activity on these sites, including contractors on the property conducting site investigation and survey work.
