New home for 61 King Street

Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities previously wrote to you to let you know that we were considering a plan to place a second house on the property at 61 King St, Hikurangi.

As a person and/or whānau who has an interest in this site, we wanted to confirm that this work will soon be taking place. The existing public house will remain and we will be adding a second house to the back section.

Work to prepare the site for this new home is expected to commence Monday 6 March. The work being completed during the first week includes a surveyor attending and temporary fencing installation.

The new three-bedroom home has been built by Massey High School students under the supervision of registered builders and teachers. It will be transported via truck from Auckland to Hikurangi and it is scheduled to be delivered on Wednesday 15 March.

Please note, the new house will need to be transported to the property in the early hours of the morning, and we apologise in advance for any disruption this may cause.

Once the house is in place, local build partner Far North Roding Group will complete the final onsite building works. The expected timeline for the completion is June 2023. If you have any questions, please contact me via the details below.
