Arlington Apartments redevelopment, Wellington – demolition update

This letter is to update you again on progress with the demolition of the George Porter Tower, as part of Kāinga Ora's redevelopment of the site for public housing. It follows our last letter in early July ahead of demolition starting.

Quality Demolition and Contracting Ltd has now demolished most of the Tower, and would like to thank you for your patience and understanding to date as we have done this work.

This week we are starting to remove the demolished material from the site with trucks. Clearing this will also allow us to complete the final demolition of the lower part of the tower. From next week we expect there to be increased truck movements so we can get this work done more quickly to minimise the period of truck activity.

We expect most trucks to enter and leave the site from Arlington Street. They will go in one entrance and out the other, which will mean there is no need for backing and turning. As the removal of material progresses they may need to use the Hopper Street gate. We will have someone managing the gates and ensuring public safety as the trucks enter and exit the site.

Footpath and road access will remain in place. We do ask if you are in the area to be extra vigilant and careful as you pass through. Your and our safety is our highest priority as we do this work.

Hours of work will continue to be between 7.30am and 5.30pm, Monday to Saturday unless unforeseen circumstances arise which may cause these hours to be altered. This work is weather dependent. We will continue to dampen down any dust with a misting spray, silt controls remain in place, with all controls monitored. Site hoardings and other site protection is in place.
