

# NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

## ALTERATION TO EXISTING TRAFFIC CONTROL: MOVEMENT OF TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNALS & WORK ZONE

This letter is to inform residents of Hankey Street of the next stage (stage-two) of our current work.

Dear residents, this notice is to inform that on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021**, we will be beginning the next stage of our current work on Hankey Street. We will be shifting our work-zone slightly further down Hankey Street and around the bend (please see below traffic management diagram).

As a result, you will notice the traffic-signals will be moved in conjunction with this alteration. We again kindly remind all residents and vehicle owners **not to park** in the stretch of road opposite our green work-zone, or in a proximity which would cause an inability for emergency vehicles or the public's throughfare.

**Please be reminded:** A clearway is required to provide sufficient space for emergency vehicles to pass through at all times. This point is of paramount importance with our traffic management plan, hence the reason we require vehicles to adhere to our parking requirements. Since this traffic management system is in place overnight, there is to be no parking in the clearway zone (space between traffic-signals) at any time.

As previously advised, vehicles parked in direct way of either our work-zone or public throughfare **will be towed**. When vehicles are towed, they are moved to the nearest available coupon parking space. The tow company then takes the registration of the vehicle and the address the vehicle is towed to, which the council has on record.

As a result of us moving further down, some parks will now be free to use on the top-end of Hankey Street. Once we've begun the next stage, please take note of where we are working and use your best judgement on parks which have again become free to use. Again, Multi Civil Contractors and on behalf of our traffic management team, thank residents for their ongoing patience and consideration in terms of disruption to on-street parking.
