RE: ROADWORKS IN YOUR AREA

Dear Business / Property Owner / Resident

Northpower has been contracted by the power network owner, Wellington Electricity, to undertake some maintenance in your area.

The particulars of the work are as follows:

Location of work:	12 Hargreaves St, Mt Cook, Wgtn.
Description of work:	<p>The berm substation located at 12 Hargreaves St is to be replaced and upgraded. This will require the 11000 volt cables to be de energised while work proceeds.</p> <p>To keep customers power on during this period a generator will be placed outside 16 Hargreaves St.</p> <p>The advertised shutdown on Friday 27 May is required to connect the generator.</p> <p>The generator will be in use from Friday 27 May 2022 until Friday 3 June 2022.</p> <p>We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause but this is the only option available to maintain power for all customers fed from the substation being replaced.</p>
Expected duration:	Approximately 8 days
Proposed days / hours of work:	<p>The excavation work in the footpath proposed to start on Thursday 26 May 2022 and will continue through to Fri 3 June 2022.</p> <p>Hours of work are to be from 9 am to 4 pm (Mondays to Fridays) only.</p>
Traffic Management and Parking Restrictions:	<p>To complete our work as quickly and as safely as possible, there will be some traffic management and also some pedestrian diversions put in place, with parking restrictions, while we are working.</p> <p>The road shoulder will be closed with "No Parking" in place.</p> <p>We understand that this work may cause you some inconvenience, for which we would already like to apologise in advance; but, please bear with us while we get this work done as quickly and safely as possible.</p>
Safety Advice:	Please remain outside any work zones and well back from any open excavations, machinery, trucks, or equipment.

Typical site hazards may include live electrical cables and other utility services, open excavations, machinery, Generator and trucks operating, trip hazards and uneven surfaces. Please follow the directions of site staff and warn your children about the potential dangers.
