Glossary



	Homes removed from service			
Those homes that are in the process of being redeveloped/demolished, retrofitted, having major repairs or being disposed of				
Unavailable Homes - in construction				
Major Repairs	Homes removed from service because they have been significantly damaged, e.g. fire, chemical or natural hazard. Some are under repair, while others will be pending a decision on their future.			
Retrofit Process	Part of the renewal programme to bring old homes up to modern standards and realign the portfolio to match the needs of its customers, optimise land use, & increase New Zealand's total housing stock. Includes homes being used as temporary accommodation* while tenants existing homes are being retrofitted.			
Redevelopment / Disposal				
Redevelopment process	These are homes that have been tagged for redevelopment, are waiting on final investment planning to be completed and a business case approved before being demolished. A fixed term tenancy is impracticable due to timeframes and or costs.			
Demolition Process	These are homes that are to be redeveloped where a business case has been approved and are actively in the process of being demolished.			
Sales & Lease expiry	Homes leaving the portfolio by either going through the process of being sold or the lease coming up to expiry and not intended to be renewed.
